St. Paul's Independent School works with pupils who have had struggled in their education for a variety of reasons. The School focuses on a trauma informed and restorative approach where relationships are central to all that we do. The pupils all have Education Health and Care Plans (EHCPs) and the focus is very much about capabilities and not disabilities.

Job Purpose:

To teach small groups of key stage 2, 3 and 4 pupils an educational programme of study. To work together with other Designated Safeguarding Leads to ensure the safety of all our pupils across our whole school provision. To lead on pastoral provision via form group and the wider school. All of our pupils have EHCPs with a focus on autism, ADHD, and social, emotional and mental health difficulties and mild learning difficulties. Experience of working with young people who have SEN / challenging behaviour in an educational setting and enthusiasm for learning and the ability to convey this to pupils is essential along with a Vocational Qualification at L3 or above.
